#### General

Regatta Chairman John Papadopoulos, Lido 14 Fleet 1, and Balboa Yacht Club extend an invitation to all Junior members of the Lido 14 Class Association to participate in the 2001 Lido 14 Jr. Class Championship Regatta this coming August 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> in Newport Beach, California. The first day of the event will consist of clinics, on and off the water, regarding boat handling, tactics, etc. The day will finish with a practice race. Day 2 will consist of racing for the title of Junior Class Champion. Though not required, all competitors are urged to take part in the events of both days.

#### Rules

The Jr. Class Championship Regatta will be governed by the 2001-2004 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the U.S. Sailing Association, the rules of the Lido 14 International Class Association, this Notice of Race (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions), and the Sailing Instructions.

#### Eligibility

Any person who has not reached their <u>19<sup>th</sup> birthday by December 31<sup>st</sup> 2001</u><sup>1</sup> and also fits one of the following membership categories is eligible to compete in this event: dependent children of Senior members of the Association (Junior Dependent Member), juniors members who own their own boat (Junior Member), or juniors members who are partners in owning a boat (Junior Syndicate Member). Class By-Law Article XVII.3, which pertains to having raced Lido 14s 60 days prior to the event, is waived for this event. Crews must meet the age restriction too.

#### Measurement

The total minimum weight of skipper, crew and ballast shall be two hundred (200) pounds. All participants **MUST** weight in at the registration desk during the Registration/Check-In time periods listed in the Schedule of Events.

All boats used in this event must demonstrate compliance to the Class Rules requiring boats and ballast to weigh a minimum of three hundred ten (310) pounds. A valid Official Certificate of Measurement & Registration or a memo from a Fleet Measurer showing the minimum being met, or an actual weigh-in of the boat at the event are sufficient to demonstrate compliance for this event.

Ballast weights will be provided to competitors chartering boats. All other competitors are responsible for bringing their own ballast.

### Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available during the Regatta Registration/Check-In periods noted in the Schedule of Events.
