Willamette Sailing Club Al Morris Memorial Regatta

July 13-14, 2002

WSC's annual regatta will take place at Yale Reservoir, located approximately 30 miles east of Woodland, Washington. Take I-5 to the Woodland Exit, go east on HWY 503 to the community of Cougar, then $\frac{1}{2}$ mile farther to the entrance of the Pacific Power Cougar Campground. Camping will be available either in the general campground on a first-come basis or by signing up for camping in the group site on the registration form.

- REGISTRATION: \$15 per boat (Skippers under 21 years \$10).
- CAMPING: (Group Site only): \$20 per family. We have the site for Friday and Saturday nights. This is a tent area only; no RVs or "pop-up" tent trailers are allowed. Since only 15 cars can be parked in the group camping area, the first 15 preregistrations received will receive passes to park in this area overnight.
- OTHER ACCOMMODATIONS: Contact The Lone Fir Resort (360) 238-5210 or Cougar RV Park & Campground (360) 238-5224 for RVs, pop-up tent trailers, or for a real honest-to-goodness room with a bed.
- SATURDAY NIGHT DINNER: \$5 per person, includes a variety of salads, desserts, condiments, soft drinks, utensils, and barbecues. Bring your own main dish or something to toss on the grill.
- OTHER FEES: Pacific Power will charge \$3 for ramp fee and \$2 for day use fee each
 day. No "walk-ins" are allowed. Only 15 cars can be parked inside the group campsite.
 Additional cars may be parked in the day use parking area for \$5 per night. (Yes, carpooling is a good thing!)
- CLASSES: Four registered one-design boats constitute a fleet. Smaller fleets will sail under the Portsmouth Handicap System. Expected classes: Lasers, Laser Radials, Tasars, Thistles, Lidos, Snipes, and Europes. US Coast Guard approved life jackets must be worn when on the water.
- TROPHIES: Awards will be presented following the last race on Sunday. One trophy for 1-4 boats, two trophies for 5-7 boats, and three for 8 or more boats.
- RACE SCHEDULE: Skippers meeting Saturday July 13 at 10:30 am near the group site restrooms. Warning flag for first race Saturday is 12 noon. The warning flag on Sunday July 14 will be at 10 am. No races will be started after 2 pm Sunday.
- ALCOHOL: Cougar Park is an alcohol free park and is enforced like Pasco.
- PETS: Pets are allowed but must be attended at all times and always on a leash.
