Rules:

This regatta is governed by the 2001-2004 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the US Sailing Association, the current Lido 14 Class Association By-Laws and the Sailing Instructions of this regatta, which shall apply in the event of conflict.

Eligibility:

Entry:

The entry fee is \$32. A \$3 discount is available for US Sailing Association members. There will be three Lido 14 fleets available for entry: A, B or C. Dinner is included in the entry fee. Extra dinners are \$6.00 adults, \$3.00 children. Please use the entry form included with this notice. Check-in and late registration entry forms will be processed at the Club from 09:00 to 10:30 Saturday morning. **Late Registration Fee of \$5.00** for entry forms received **after October 9, 2002.**

Racing Area/Courses/Sailing Instructions:

The racing area will be the Sail Bay part of Mission Bay. The courses will be those described on the Mission Bay Yacht Club (MBYC) **Bay Courses Chart** included with the Sailing Instructions. Sailing Instructions with course charts will be available during the check-in period 09:00 to 10:30 Saturday morning.

Scoring:

The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply. Five races are scheduled, of which 1 race shall be completed to constitute a regatta. There will be no throw-out race.

Awards:

Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after racing on Sunday. Trophies will be awarded to both skipper and crew for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for A and B fleets and 1st place for the C fleet.

Special Trophy:

A new and original perpetual trophy has been created for the Fall Invitational Regatta and donated to Fleet 7 by Dolores Lesnick in honor and memory of her husband Robert N. Lesnick, a former Fleet7 member, Lido14 owner and competitor. This new perpetual trophy will be presented at the awards ceremony. The 1st place winner in the A-Fleet will have their name inscribed on a plaque at the base of this trophy.

Special Events After Racing:

On Saturday night: there will be a cyo dinner with food provided by the members of Fleet7. Cooking will be done on the south end barbeque burners, next to the Bodrero Bldg. (Jr. Clubhouse). The Bodrero Bldg. has been reserved so that all regatta participants can dine together in the fleet room. There is a no host bar available in the main clubhouse.

After racing on Sunday: Fleet7 will provide chili& fixin's and snacks on the patio of the main clubhouse. Awards presentations will also be at that location.

Facilities: Mission Bay Yacht Club is located at 1215 El Carmel Place, San Diego, CA 92109. ph. 858-488-0501. There is a hoist, dry storage and parking. A snack bar is available for buying breakfast & lunch. The bar in the main clubhouse opens at 12:00 on Saturday and Sunday. Due to Mission Bay Park regulations, MBYC is unable to allow overnight camping on its premises.

RACE ENTRY AGREEMENT

To the Mission Bay Yacht Club:

In consideration of your acceptance of my entry, I agree as follows:

1. My yacht will be equipped to conform with any USCG or US SAILING safety requirements and those of any fleet in which I shall compete.
2. Any contestant may inspect my yacht before or after the race.
3. I agree with the Club and all other contestants to comply with all rules and sailing instructions governing the race.
4. I hereby release the Club, its officers, agents and committee personnel from any and all liability for any injury to myself or my yacht arising out of their conduct of the race or my use of the facilities to the extent that such release does not discharge my insurance carrier under the provisions of insurance policies on my yacht.
5. I assume any risk of injury arising out of my participation in the race, failure or breakage of my yacht or any of its equipment, or weather conditions.
6. I certify that my crew and I are able to swim.
7. I will notify the Club or the race committee immediately upon withdrawal from the race.
