competitors. Boats must be equipped with an internal sling to use with BCYC's boat hoist.

9. TROPHIES: Perpetual Trophies will be awarded for first place overall and the first "B" team. Take home

trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew for the first three (3) teams (overall) and the first "B" team. "B" teams are those with skippers that meet the Class Rules for racing in "B" flights of

regattas that also specify their status on the accompanying entry form.
