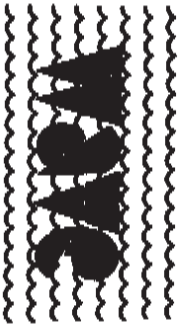

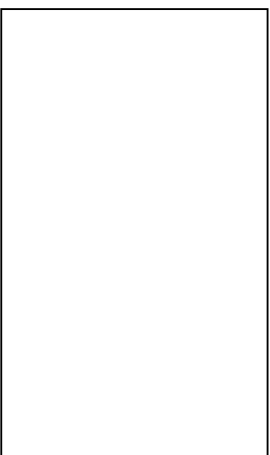

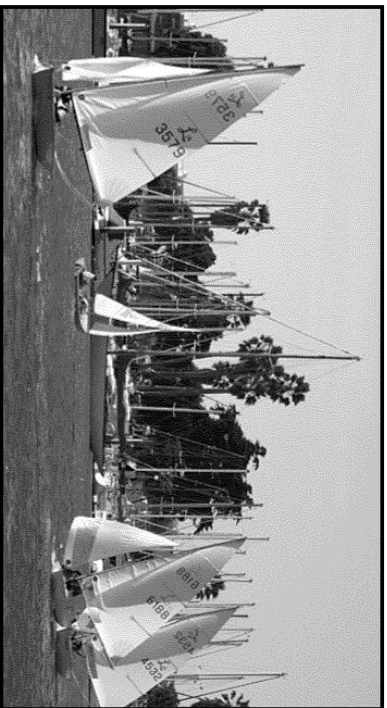

ALAMITOS BAY TURKEY DAY REGATTA

November 22 & 23, 2004

Alamitos Bay Yacht Club hosted another gigantic regatta with over 227 boats entered in 22 classes! To further confound the parking and storage situation, the City of Long Beach was in the process of repaving Ocean Blvd. and tow away signs were posted from the yacht club to 54th street, a mile away.

Crowded into the turning basin were 74 Sabots, 9 CFJ's and 20 Lido 14s, nearly half the the overall entry for the entire regatta. Promise of a brisk wind Saturday died to a 6-10 knot breeze by the time things got started and the scheduled 4 races for the day was reduced to 3. At the end of the day Greg and Buddy Rodgers were on top of the A Fleet with 3, 1, 1 finishes, giving them a two point lead over Stu Robertson and Jim Olson with 8 points. In the B Fleet, only 2 points separated the top four boats with Nancy Davidson and Missy York leading the pack. Stu Robertson hosted a barbecue at his home following the Saturday experience and a good time was had by all attending.

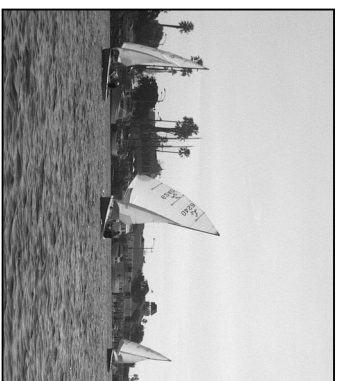
Sunday the wind was easterly (180 degrees from the usual) and very light. Temporary marks were used for the windward-leeward courses and only 2 races were able to be completed. Stu Robertson overcame Greg Rodgers advantage to take the A Fleet with Bob Yates and Pat Kincaid taking the third place tie-breaker over Tom and Bette Jenkins. In the B Fleet, Nancy Davidson continued her string of 1st's to take the regatta. Grant Hill and Brandon Conner finished 2nd, and Tracy Conn and Mark Stanifer finished tied with Dave and Marilyn Callender.

The 2004 sailing season got off to great start with 22 Lido 14 teams enjoying beautiful weather and great sailing conditions.

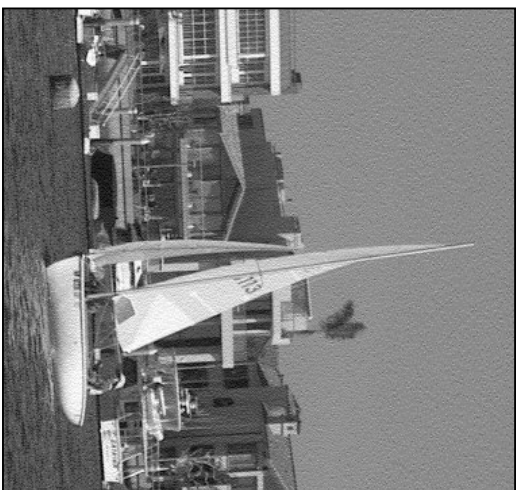
