2. ELIGIBIITY AND ENTRIES

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats participating at the 2005 W.D. Schock Memorial Regatta.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting an entry form to NHYC no later than 1500 on Friday 3/4/05.

3. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available 3/4/05 at NHYC.

4. RACING AREA

Racing will take place in the harbor north of the Newport Harbor Yacht Club Main Dock.

5. THE START

- 5.1 The First Warning will be at 1600.
- 5.2 Races will be started using Appendix Q. The start for boat insufficient to form a class may be combined with another class at the discretion of the Race Committee.

7. PROTESTS

Protest will be heard in the 3-minute justice format by a jury of your peers.

8. SCORING

Combination of computer program and AP coaches poll, based on low point finishes and style points for sailing, crew attire, crew work and most spectacular mark rounding as determined by an expert panel. (This system will most likely determine a cochampion...)

9. TROPHIES:

Trophies will be awarded on Saturday, March, 6, 2004
