District II Championship & Tie Dye Regatta

Sponsored by Fleet 62 and the Fremont Sailing Club

June 27, 28

Fleet 62 would like to invite all Lido 14 Sailors to Lake Elizabeth in Fremont for the Fremont Sailing Club Summer Regatta and District II Championship Tie Dye Regatta.

Rules: The race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the individual class rules and the Sailing Instructions (available at the skippers meeting).

Eligibility and Entry: This regatta is open to all Lido 14 class boats, however only boats that are registered with the Lido Class Association and are part of District II are eligible to win the District II championship. If a non eligible boat wins the regatta a separate trophy will be provided and the District II championship shall be the highest placing eligible boat. Yachts may enter by filing a completed entry form, with fees prior to the close of registration at 11:00 AM Saturday, June 27, 2009. The entry fee is \$30.00 per boat. After June. 17, 2008 the entry fee is \$35.00. Entry form can be sent to:

The cost of entry includes the launch fee for both days, District II barbecue for Saturday Night. Tie Dye is encourage, but not required.

Skippers Meeting: 11:00 AM and first gun at 12:00 wind permitting. All announcements at Skippers Meeting override the Notice of Race.

Scoring: The usual low score system. If 5 or more races completed there will be one throw out. 2 trophies per fleet.

Fleets: Over 10 boats, A and B Fleets with separate starts, otherwise just an A & B Fleet combined start.

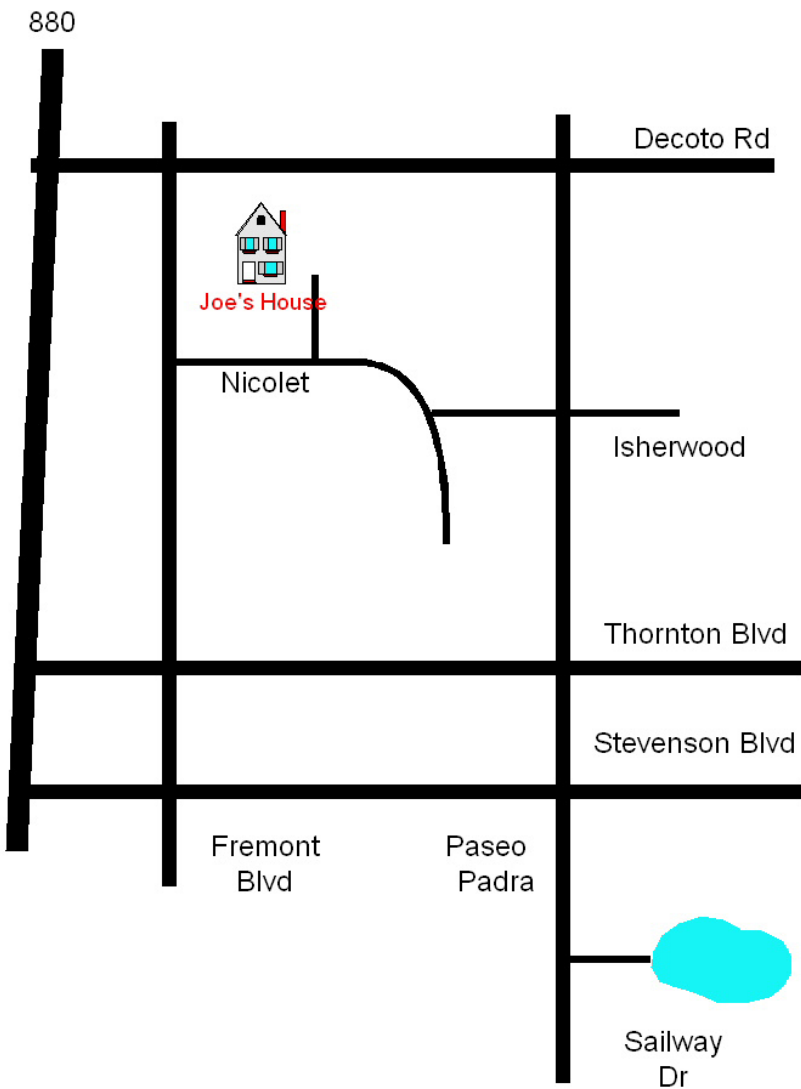
