### NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority will be the Alamitos Bay Yacht Club, Long Beach, CA

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and the ByLaws of the Lido Class Association.
- 1.2. The timing sequence of rule 26 will be changed. The changes will appear in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. This regatta is open to skippers and crews will not be twenty until after 12/31/2010. Sailors do not have to be a member of the Lido Class Association and all junior sailors are welcome. Many loaner boats will be made available free of charge. Please make requests for a loaner boat well in advance of the event to Regatta Chair Sarah Ryan 562-322-2880
- 2.2. This regatta is open to members' "in good standing" of an SCYA affiliated yacht club, to members of US SAILING Association-affiliated yacht clubs if they reside outside the SCYA area, and to foreign sailors who are members of their respective National Governing Authorities and their dependents.

#### 3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1. Five (5) races are scheduled.
- 3.2. The Warning Signal for the first race each day will be at 1155.

#### 4. ENTRIES AND FEES

Entry fees are as follows:

Eligible boats may enter online or in person. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED VIA MAIL OR FAX. Online entries will be accepted until 1600 on the Friday immediately preceding the regatta; thereafter entries may only be made in person. In-person entries will be accepted 1000 for Bay Classes on regatta morning.

#### 5. COMPETITORS' MEETINGS

Competitors' meetings will be held on the ABYC patio on Sunday at 1030.

#### 6. SUPPORT BOATS

All support boats, including coach and spectator boats, must check in at registration prior to the competitors' briefing and shall meet with a race official immediately following the competitors' meeting.



## **7. SCORING**

7.1. When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

7.2. One (1) race constitutes a series.

## **8. TROPHIES**

Trophies will be awarded to the following schedule:

Five (5) boats	One (1) trophy;
Six (6) to eight (8)	Two (2) trophies;
Nine (9) to 11	Three (3) trophies;
12 to 14	Four (4) trophies;
15 or more	Five (5) trophies.

## **9. PARKING AND STORAGE**

Due to space limitations, parking on ABYC grounds is restricted. Off-street parking is available across the street in municipal lots. Participants should obtain parking passes from the ABYC office. Participants may bring their boats into the ABYC yard on Friday between 0900 and 1700. Extended storage prior to the regatta on a space-available basis may be requested IN ADVANCE with Kelly Whitlow, ABYC Club manager and standard rate is \$5.00 a day prepaid. Prepaid boats will have an authorization tag attached to their dolly/trailer showing. Any boat (s) or trailer(s) left after the regatta may be impounded and will be locked up in the East yard and will only be released upon paying impound storage fees. NOTE: ABYC is closed on Monday and Tuesday except for card-key access to the grounds..

## **10. HOSPITALITY**

The hospitality of ABYC is extended to all participants. The Galley will be open each day. Regatta Breakfast menu and bag lunches will be available. The club bar will be open after racing for those with proper identification.

## **11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authorities will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

## **12. SAFETY**

ABYC recommends that all competitors wear personal flotation devices while on the water. The Y flag (personal flotation required) will be flown at all regattas from October 15 through April 14, and it may be flown at other regattas.
