

Notice of Race
Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club (SMWYC) and Lido 14 Fleet 2 present the
2010 Super Bowl Charity Regatta
Sunday, January 31, 2010

Rules. This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing(RRS)* (2009 -2012).

Eligibility and entry. This racing series is open to all boats of the Lido 14 Class Association and guests of Lido 14 Fleet 2. Invitations have been made to the C-15, Multihulls and Laser Fleets.

Entry forms will be available the morning of the regatta and may be available on the SMWYC website. The contribution to enter the regatta shall be \$10.00 payable to the Wellness Community. This is a charity event and the contribution fee is optional. The entry deadline is Sunday, January 31, 2010 at 1000 hours. Entries may be delivered the morning of the event or mailed to SMWYC at the address listed below.

Divisions. It is intended to have one start for all Lido sailors. If event participation warrants it, separate starts may be implemented for A & B fleets at the discretion of the race committee. In the event the C-15's, multi-hulls and Lasers do enter in sufficient number to earn a start, at the race committee's discretion, the race committee shall establish an order of starts no later than 1000 hours the morning of the race.

Location. Racing will be held in the Outer Channel of Marina del Rey inside the "No Sail" lanes. Course charts will be available along with Sailing Instructions no later than 1000 hours the morning of the regatta. If conditions dictate, the Race Committee may indicate "Come within Hail/ Follow Me" by with multiple sound signals and the hoisting of an L Flag, at which point the race committee may move and change the location of the racing venue.

Skipper's meeting. A skipper's meeting will be held at SMWYC at 1000 hours the morning of the regatta. The order of starts will be announced and posted at such time.

The Start. Starts will be administered in accordance with Appendix S of the *RRS*. The first start is scheduled for 12:00 noon.

Scoring. Scoring shall be by the Low Point System as defined in the *RRS*, except that all scores shall count (ie. No throw out at six races). One race shall constitute a regatta.

Launching. Hoists are available at both SMWYC, 13589 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292, 310-827-7692, www.smwyc.org and South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club (SCCYC), 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292, www.sccyc.org Boats may also be trailer launched at a public launch ramp across from SCCYC for a fee of \$7.00.

Awards and Hospitality. A Miami themed dinner (feast), \$5 per plate, results and multiple awards shall be presented at the SMWYC Clubhouse following the event and haul out of competing boats. We hope to have two or three guest speakers,
