Rules: This regatta is governed by the 2001-2004 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the US Sailing Association, the current Lido 14 International Class Association By-Laws and the sailing instructions of this regatta, which shall apply in the event of conflict.

Eligibility: This regatta is open to all members of the Lido 14 International Class Association.

Entry: The entry fee is \$33. A \$3 discount is available for US Sailing Association members. There will be three Lido 14 fleets available for entry: A, B or C. Racing Area/Courses/Sailing Instructions:

The racing area will be the Sail Bay part of Mission Bay. The courses will be those described on the Mission Bay Race Chart included with the sailing instructions. Sailing instructions with course charts will be available during the check-in period 9:00 to 10:30 Saturday morning. A skippers' meeting will held at 10:30 in the main dining room.

Scoring: The low point scoring system outlined in the RRS Appendix A2, will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. Five races are scheduled, of which 1 race shall be completed to constitute a regatta.

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after racing on Sunday. Trophies will be awarded to both skipper and crew for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for A and B fleets and 1st place for the C fleet.
