## 2001 SCHOCK INVITATIONAL REGATTA

October 5-7, 2001

### NOTICE OF RACE

**Organizing Authority:** The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1. **RULES:** This event will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
2. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:**
  - 2.1 The regatta is open to one design boats built by the W.D. Schock Corporation.
  - 2.2 Eligible competitors may enter by completing the attached Entry Form and returning it with appropriate fee to The San Francisco Yacht Club Race Office.
  - 2.3 The following entry fees will apply to entries postmarked prior to September 19, 2001: Boats 10-19' \$40, Boats 20-25' \$60, Boats 26-30' \$80, Boats 31-40' \$100. A late fee of \$15 will be charged for all entries postmarked after September 19.
  - 2.4 The entry fee includes complimentary tickets to the Saturday night Buffet Dinner, as follows: Boats 10-19' - 1 ticket, Boats 20-25' - 2 tickets, Boats 26-30' - 3 tickets, Boats 31-40' - 4 tickets.
  - 2.5 If fewer than five boats in a fleet are registered by October first, the race committee may refund the entry fees received and not give the fleet a start.

### 3. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS (Cont.)

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4. **TRAILER STORAGE:** Competitors with boats on trailers are required to check with the Harbormaster as soon as possible after arrival for directions on offsite storage of trailers.
5. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Sailing instructions will be available upon registration at The San Francisco Yacht Club.
6. **RACING AREA:** Races will be held in the vicinity of Southampton Shoal (Group 1), except races for the Lido 14 fleet (Group 2) will be held in Richardson Bay. The tune up race for Group 1 will be in the vicinity of Knox Buoy, and for Group 2 in Belvedere Cove.
7. **COMMUNICATIONS:** Group I race committee may use VHF Channel 71 to communicate information about time to start and OCS. Neither failure of the race committee to communicate the sail numbers of recalled boats in a timely manner, nor failure of a recalled boat to receive or hear transmitted information, will be grounds for redress (affects RRS 62).
8. **COURSES:** The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.
9. **PERSONAL BUOYANCY**  
All competitors are urged to wear life jackets or adequate personal buoyancy while racing.
10. **GUEST BERTHING:** The SFYC guest dock will be available from Thursday, October 4, through Monday, October 8.
11. **SCORING:**
  - 8.1 The Friday night tune-up race will not count toward the final regatta score.
  - 8.2 The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A2, will apply for the series, changed so that each boat's worst score will be discarded only if five races are completed. Five races are scheduled, of which two races shall be completed to constitute a series.
12. **TROPHIES:**
  - 12.1 A trophy presentation will be held on the Club deck following the racing on October 7.
  - 12.2 Trophies will be awarded as follows:
    - Lido 14 – Western Regional Championship
    - Santana 20 – Fall Schock Regatta
    - Santana 22 – Gary Mull Cappuccino Cup
    - Santana 35 – National Championship
    - Wavelength 24 – Fall Schock Regatta
  - 12.3 Additional place trophies will be awarded for each fleet based on the number of entries received.
