Notice of Race

RULES

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 1997-2000, the prescriptions of US SAILING; the rules of each of the classes, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions, and by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

ELIGIBILITY

The following boats are invited to enter:

Ocean Course: NY 36, Schock 35, Schock 40, Santana 30/30, Santana 20, Thistle, Wavelength 24,

Bay Course: Harbor 20 A & B, Lido 14 A & B, and Lehman 12 A & B

For this regatta only the skipper must be a member of US Sailing or a recognized club under ISAF.

ENTRY AND ENTRY FEES

The following entry fees will apply to entries postmarked prior to February 25, 2001:

Boats 10'-19' \$50

Boats 26'-30' \$100

Boats 20'-25' \$75

Boats 31'-40' \$125

The entry fee includes tickets for Saturday's dinner based on the size of the boat. (See Social and Meals section for number of tickets included per size category of boat). REGISTRATION

COMPETITOR'S MEETING

A competitor's meeting will be held at NHYC on Saturday, March 3 at 0930 for the outside courses and 1100 for the inside courses.

RACES & RACING AREA

The Race Committee will attempt to complete five races for all boats on the ocean course, 6 races for the Harbor 20, and 9 races for Lehman 12s and Lido 14s racing on the bay course.

Two separate ocean racing areas may be used and the location for each will be described in the Sailing Instructions. The bay course will be in the turning basin in front of NHYC.

COURSES

The courses to be used will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

HAILING

The race committees will attempt to use VHF radios to announce recalls on the outside courses only. It is still the responsibility of each competitor to ensure proper starting. Failure of equipment either on the race committee boat or a competitor shall not be grounds for redress.

SHORESIDE ANNOUNCEMENT

Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted at Newport Harbor Yacht Club. On Saturday evening and Sunday morning any changes to the Sailing Instructions will be sent to Balboa Yacht Club for posting to aid boats sailing out of Balboa Yacht Club.

SCORING

The Low-Point Scoring System, rule A2, will apply with 5, 6 or 9 races scheduled of which two shall be completed to constitute a series. Each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to class winners based on the number of entries. Trophies will be awarded on Sunday, March 4, 2001 as soon as possible after the last race.
