Safety: Alamitos Bay Yacht Club (ABYC) recommends that all competitors wear personal flotation devices while on the water. The Y flag (personal flotation required while racing) will be flown at this regatta. Boats shall be equipped with a painter suitable for towing.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the 'rules', as defined in the 2001-2004 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), which include the rules of the Lido 14 Class Association. In the event of a conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail. Sailing Instructions and Course Charts will be issued at Registration. Written protests are disallowed at this event; this modifies the RRS and Lido 14 Class Association rules.

Classes: Lido 14 A & B. Five (5) entries are required to establish a class. "A" and "B" may be sailed together but will be scored separately.

Eligibility: This regatta is open to all sailors. Lido 14 Class Association membership and boat ownership requirements are waived for this regatta.

Entry: All competitors, to be eligible to race, shall register using Entry Forms provided during the Registration period. There is no Entry Fee for this regatta however donations for The Susan B. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation are encouraged. A \$15.00 donation per boat is suggested. Please make checks payable to **The Susan B. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation**. Visit www.komen.org for further information on this foundation.

Location: Registration, Competitors' Meeting, and after racing events will be held on the ABYC Patio Deck. Sailing will be outside Alamitos Bay but inside the outer breakwater.

Schedule:

Registration: 0900-1000 hours
Competitors' Meeting: 1000 hours
Race #1 First Warning: 1200 hours
Race #2 First Warning: ASAP
Race #3 First Warning: ASAP
Race #4 First Warning: ASAP
Aprés Sail Ceremony: ASAP

Four (4) races are scheduled. One (1) completed race shall constitute a series.

Scoring: The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply except that a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This modifies RRS A.2.

Parking: Guest parking on ABYC grounds is not available. Off-street parking is available in the municipal parking lots across from ABYC. Free daily parking passes for the municipal lots are available at the ABYC front office.

Launching: Two hoists and a dinghy launch ramp are available. Competitors using a boat hoist must use an INTERNAL lifting sling.

Hospitality: The hospitality of ABYC is extended to all participants. The Galley will be open from 0900 to 1630. Breakfast will be served from 0900 to 1030. Bag lunches will be available from the Galley.
