### NOTICE OF RACE

SATURDAY & SUNDAY, MARCH 8 & 9, 2003

ALAMITOS BAY YACHT CLUB

PLEASE NOTICE: The Y flag (personal flotation required) will be flown at this regatta.

RULES: This regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the rules of each participating class, this Notice of Race (except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions), and the ABYC Sailing Instructions.

ELIGIBILITY: Small sailboats (monohull and multihull) not exceeding 20' in length overall and not having a fixed keel, owned or under charter to a member of a yacht club "in good standing" with the Southern California Yachting Association, or if a non-resident of the S.C.Y.A. area, a member of a yacht club recognized and "in good standing" with the United States Sailing Association or the International Sailing Federation.

CLASSES: A class will be established with a minimum of 5 entries. All classes will race at Alamitos Bay Yacht Club. Bay and Ocean Courses will be used. A painter suitable for towing, at least one overall boat length long, is required for every Ocean class yacht. These include such classes as the 505, Fireball, Snipe, Coronado 15 and Laser. A 10-foot painter is required for every Bay class yacht. These include such classes as the CFJ (non-spinnaker), Lido 14 and Naples Sabot.

SCHEDULE: Six races are scheduled. The first warning signal each day will be at 1120.

ENTRIES: Entries will be accepted until 1000 on Saturday. Please complete and mail the entry form. There is no entry fee.

COMPETITORS' MEETING: Competitors' meetings will be held on the ABYC patio on Saturday at 1000 for Ocean classes and 1030 for Bay classes.

TROPHIES: Trophies will be presented at ABYC after the final race on Sunday. Five trophies will be awarded for 15 or more competing yachts in a class; four for 12 to 14 competing yachts; three for 9 to 11 competing yachts; two for 6 to 8 competing yachts; one for 5 competing yachts.

The E.E. MANNING CUP will be awarded to the winner of the class with the largest number of competitors. The SKIMMER TROPHY will be awarded to the winner of the second largest class. The KOBER PERPETUAL TROPHY will be awarded to the winner of the Naples Sabot class. The HOST CLUB TROPHY will be awarded at the discretion of the race committee to the most deserving junior sailor.

ARBITRATION: All protests involving rules of Part 2 will first be submitted to arbitration. The arbitration procedure will be posted on the Official Regatta Notice Board as an addendum to the Sailing Instructions.

LAUNCHING: Two hoists and a launching ramp are available. Every boat using a hoist must have its own INTERNAL sling.

STORAGE: Overnight storage of boats and trailers is available during the regatta. Participants may bring their boats into the ABYC yard on the Friday before the regatta between 0900 and 1700. Extended storage on a space-available basis may be requested IN ADVANCE by contacting the ABYC office at (562) 434-9955.

NOTE: ABYC is closed on Monday and Tuesday except for card-key access to the grounds.

HOSPITALITY: The hospitality of ABYC is extended to all participants. The ABYC Galley will be open from 0900 to 1630. Breakfast is served from 0900 from 1030. Lunches (including bag lunches), snacks, soft drinks and beer will be available. The Wardroom Bar will be open at 1600 each racing day; you must be at least 21 years of age to enter the Wardroom.

PARKING: Because space is limited, parking on ABYC grounds is restricted. Off-street parking is available across the street in municipal lots. Participants should obtain passes from the ABYC office.
