

# Notice of Race

## Harry Wood Memorial Regatta

**Balboa Yacht Club**  
**Sunday March 28<sup>th</sup>, 2004**

**1. RULES:** The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of the Lido 14 Class Association. Advertising shall be restricted to Category A per RRS Appendix 1 Regulation 20.

**2. DIVISIONS:** Lido 14 A, Lido 14 B, Lido 14 Grand Master (Skipper 50+ years of age). The race committee reserves the right to start two or more divisions simultaneously however all divisions will be scored separately. In the event that all divisions are sailed together, all skippers over the age of 50 will be automatically entered into the Grand Master division.

**3. ELIGIBILITY:** This regatta is open to all teams that meet the following eligibility requirements: 1) The registered skipper shall be a current member of the Lido 14 Class Association; 2) the registered skipper shall be a current member of an SCYA member yacht club or, if a non-resident of the SCYA area, a yacht club recognized by US Sailing Association or the International Sailing Federation (ISAF).

**4. LOCATION:** Registration on the day of the regatta, the Competitors Meeting, official Race Notice Board, protest related events, after-racing buffet and awards presentation will be located at Balboa Yacht Club (BYC); located at 1801 Bayside Drive, Corona Del Mar, CA (949) 673-3515

Races, unless otherwise noted, will be held in the main turning basin of Newport Harbor, north of Newport Harbor Yacht Club.

**5. SCHEDULE:** Five (5) races are scheduled with a 15-minute break after the second race.

**6. ENTRY** Advance registration is available by mail by completing the associated entry form and either depositing it in the race entry mail slot at BYC or by mailing it to BYC at the address provided below. Mailed entries must be received by BYC no later than March 27 (Saturday). On the day of the regatta, registration will on the BYC Flag Deck. Sailing Instructions and course charts will be available the day of the regatta at the registration desk.

**7. SCORING:** The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, shall apply except that each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. This changes RRS A2. Three (3) completed races shall constitute a series.

**8. FACILITIES:** The hospitality of BYC and its facilities, **except on site automobile parking**, are extended to all competitors. Each boat must be equipped with an internal sling for use with the club boat hoists.

**9. TROPHIES:** Perpetual Trophies will be awarded for first place in each division. Take home trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew for the top three (3) boats in the A division and the top boat in the B and Grand Master divisions.
