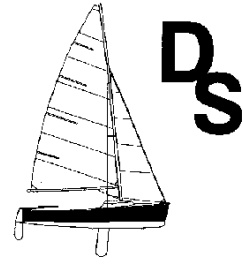




NOTICE OF RACE

and Lido District II Championship

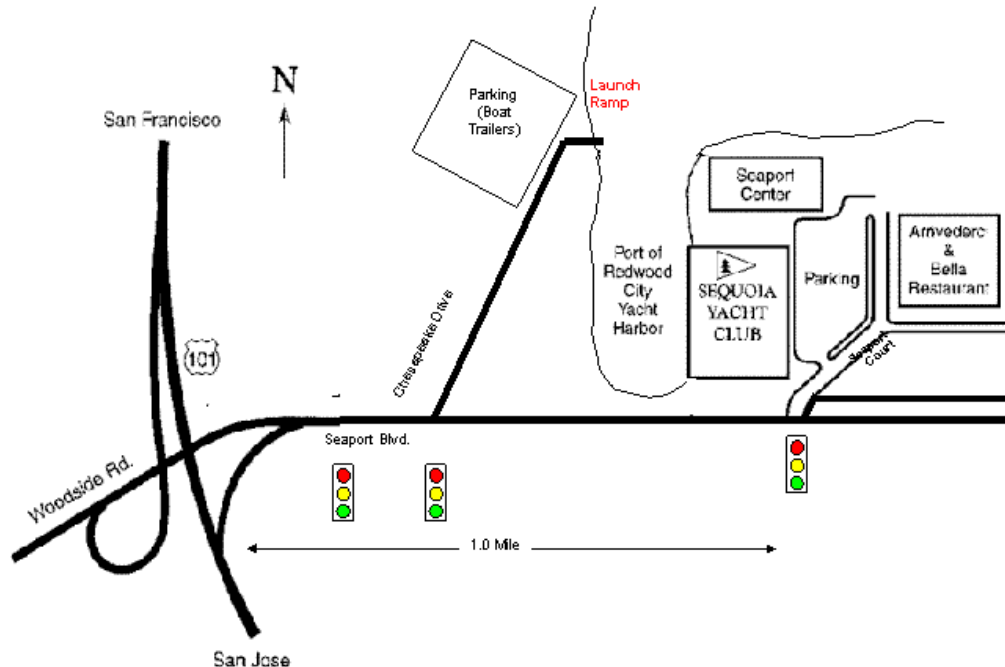
Saturday, September 17 and Sunday, September 18, 2005



Rules: The race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the individual class rules and the Sailing Instructions (available at the skippers meeting).

Eligibility and Entry: This regatta is open to all Day Sailer class boats and Lido 14 class boats racing with separate class starts. Eligible yachts may enter by filing a completed entry form, with fees prior to the close of registration at 11:00 AM Saturday, September 14, 2005. (The entry fee is \$30.00 per boat: Day Sailors make checks out to Dan Alexander. Lidors make checks out to Jack Navarra. The cost of entry includes lunch for 2 on Saturday.) After Sept. 10, 2005 the entry fee is \$40.00.

Location: Port of Redwood City turning basins. SYC Address: 451 Seaport Ct. Redwood City, CA 94063
Take the Seaport Blvd. exit from the Bayshore Freeway (Highway 101). Turn left on Chesapeake Drive. Proceed to the municipal ramp at the end of Chesapeake Drive
Launch at the municipal ramp on Chesapeake Drive (There is a \$3.50 launch fee)

Awards At the Sequoia Yacht Club

Mooring boats overnight: Boats may be left rigged overnight Saturday September 17th at the guest dock of Sequoia Yacht Club as space allows

Equipment: Yachts shall be equipped with Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Devices for both the skipper and the crew.

Scoring: The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 will apply. The worst score will be discarded if five or more races are sailed.

Prizes: Day Sailor awards will be presented to top three finishers in the A fleet, and top finisher in the B fleet for the two combined racing days, at the Sequoia YC clubhouse at the conclusion of racing. The Lido District II Championship awards will go to the top three finishers in the Lido Fleet who are members of the Lido 14 Class Association.
