General

Regatta Chairman Eric Bohman, Lido 14 Fleet 43, and Anacapa Yacht Club (“AYC”) extend an invitation to all Junior members of the Lido 14 Class Association to participate in the 2005 Lido 14 Jr. Class Championship Regatta this coming October 1st and 2nd in Oxnard, California. The first day of the event will consist of clinics, on and off the water which will focus on boat handling, tactics, etc. The day will finish with a practice race. Day 2 will consist of racing for the title of Junior Class Champion. Though not required, all competitors are urged to take part in the events of both days. Fleet 43 will be providing all boats for the event so Registration by September 10, 2005 is mandatory to insure that there are enough boats available. We will attempt to sail enough races so that each competitor sails each boat one time.

Rules

The Jr. Class Championship Regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the U.S. Sailing Association, the rules of the Lido 14 International Class Association, this Notice of Race (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions), and the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility

Any person who has not reached their 19th birthday by December 31st 2005 and also fits one of the following membership categories is eligible to compete in this event: dependent children of Senior members of the Association (Junior Dependent Member), juniors members who own their own boat (Junior Member), or juniors members who are partners in owning a boat (Junior Syndicate Member). Class By-Law Article XVII.3, which pertains to having raced Lido 14s 60 days prior to the event, is waived for this event. Crews must also meet the age restriction.

Measurement

The total minimum weight of skipper, crew and ballast shall be two hundred (200) pounds. All participants **MUST** weigh in at the registration desk during the Registration/Check-In time periods listed in the Schedule of Events.

Every attempt will be made to insure that each boat provided is similar. All boats used in this event must demonstrate compliance to the Class Rules requiring boats and ballast to weigh a minimum of three hundred ten (310) pounds. A valid Official Certificate of Measurement & Registration or a memo from a Fleet Measurer showing the minimum being met, or an actual weigh-in of the boat at the event are sufficient to demonstrate compliance for this event.

Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available during the Regatta Registration/Check-In periods noted in the Schedule of Events.
