- 1. This year a camp site is not included in your registration. [New regulations would have required reserving two nights for a group site]. If you plan to camp, register now for the regatta and on race days just show and rent a campsite [or make camp-site registrations in advance as hereafter mentioned].
- 2. Saturday Night pot luck will be held in the day use area to be announced.
- 3. Your Lido must be properly registered with California, bear a proper CF number, and be insured. Bring your boat registration and boat-liability insurance [or homeowners insurance].
- 4. This year the Regatta will be renting a Skinner Lake pontoon boat as a R/C platform. [Extra cost to your organizers].

Notice of Regatta - Skinner Lake Recreational Outing Skinner Lake, Temecula, California June 11th and 12, 2005

<u>The Regatta Sponsor</u>: This regatta is co-sponsored by the W. D. Schock Corp. and Lido 14- San Diego; and Lido 14 Fleet 7; Roger Patterson serves as the Regatta Chair.

Rules: The racing will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing [RRS], the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association and by the By Laws of the Lido 14 Class Association except as these are changed by this Notice of Regatta or by the sailing instructions. The regatta is designated Category A in accordance with Appendix G of the RRS.

<u>Eligibility</u>: This regatta is open to all members of the Lido 14 Class Association. Memberships in the Association may be purchased by persons otherwise eligible at the regatta. Membership in a yacht club or sailing association is not required for either skipper or crew. The sponsoring authority reserves the right to refuse or revoke and refund registration to any person who cannot demonstrate a reasonable familiarity with the RRS. It is the responsibility of each participant to determine whether or not his or her skill level, experience, and maturity is sufficient for participation in any race or other activity of the Regatta.

<u>Check-In and Late Registrations</u>: Check-in and late registrations will be accepted on Friday, June 10, 2005 between 3:30 and 5:00 p.m. at the Patterson campsite. And on Saturday, June 11, 2005 between 9:00 a. m. and 10:15 a. m. at the Patterson motor-home at the launch area.

<u>Sailing Instructions</u>: Sailing Instructions will be distributed at regatta check-in. The courses to be sailed will be shown on the racing instructions and in general will be of a configuration commonly referred to as windward/leeward and triangle courses.

Schedule of Races: Seven races are scheduled with four to be sailed Saturday, June 11 2005 and three races to be sailed on Sunday, June 12, 2005. A & B classes will start as the sponsor may determine appropriate in light of the sailing conditions and the number of entrants. If one or more races are finished, the regatta will be regarded as complete for registration fee and for trophy purposes. The warning for the first race on Saturday June 11, 2005 is scheduled for 1:00 p.m. The warning for the first race on Sunday June 12, 2005 is scheduled for 11:30 a.m.

<u>Scoring</u>: The Low Point scoring system, rule A2 will apply. Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores; no score will be excluded. This changes RRS A2.

<u>Trophies</u>: Trophies will be awarded BASED ON THE NUMBER OF REGISTRATIONS RECEIVED ON OR BEFORE MAY 31, 2005 with approximately one prize to each three registrations and will be awarded for both skipper and crew allocated between the top finishers of the A and of the B flights. In addition, the winner of A Class will be awarded the Skinner Lake Perpetual Trophy dedicated by Pat De Bold of Mission Bay Yacht Club.

<u>Race Committee:</u> An all star race committee will be provided from the members and friends of the Class Association. If you have someone that would like to serve, don't hesitate to speak up.

<u>Protest</u>: This regatta is presented for recreational purposes and participants are encouraged to use the 720-degree penalty alternative should a rule infringement occur. Protests, if any, will be heard immediately following conclusion of the racing on June 16, 2005 at Mission Bay Yacht Club.

The Facilities:

<u>Location</u>: Skinner Lake is located near Temecula approximately 11 miles east of Highway 15 off Rancho California Road.

<u>Camping</u>: Camp Sites at the Lake may be reserved by calling Riverside County Regional Park & Open-Space District at 800 234-7275 or by fax at 909 955-4305. Water, electricity, restrooms and showers are available. A Lake Store is available.

Other Overnight Facilities: If camping isn't your bag . . . There are many other facilities available from Motel Six to Executive Suites. Check the Internet or the yellow pages.

<u>Day use fee</u>: If you do not camp you will be required to pay a facility day use fee. Please make payment at the entry gate as you enter.

<u>Dinner Saturday Night:</u> Plan to share dinner with your competitors on Saturday evening. It is a potluck - plan to bring some food to share.

<u>Wineries</u>: There are a number of wineries featuring the finest in locally produced product.

<u>Swimming:</u> . . . is not allowed. Body contact with the water is to be avoided.

<u>Boat Launching</u>: Requires payment of a nominal fee to the County of Riverside - please pay upon your arrival at the Lake.
