

# 2005 W.D. SCHOCK MEMORIAL REGATTA



## Notice of Race March 5-6, 2005



### 1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, 2005-2008.

### 2. ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to Lehman 12(A and B Fleets), Lido 14(A and B Fleets), Harbor 20(A and B Fleets), Santana 30/30, Santana 20, Schock 35, and Schock 40 boats. Other interested One-Design classes may be invited to sail and are encouraged to contact the NHYC Race Director prior to March 1, 2005.
- 3.2 Skippers must be members of US Sailing or a recognized club under ISAF to be eligible to sail in this event.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee to the address provided on the form. Completed entry forms and entry fees payable to NHYC must be filed with Newport Harbor Yacht Club on or before March 1, 2005, to avoid late penalties.

### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available upon registration at the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.

### 6. RACING AREAS

- 6.1 Lehman 12, Lido 14, and Harbor 20 boats will be sailing in the harbor north of the Newport Harbor Yacht Club Main Dock.
- 6.2 Santana 20, Santana 30/30, Schock 35, and Schock 40 boats will be racing in the ocean off Newport Beach. The designated Ocean Racing Area for each class will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

### 7. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 7.1 Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.
- 7.2 Protest and request for redress hearings will be conducted as time-limited hearings.

### 8. SCORING

- 8.1 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 8.2 A boat’s series score will be the total of her scores for all races.

### 9. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to class winners based on the number of entries on Sunday, March 6, 2005, as soon as possible after the last race.

### 10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunctions with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
