



NOTICE OF RACE

Semana Nautica Regatta Santa Barbara Yacht Club Santa Barbara, CA

June 25-26, 2005

1. HOST AND ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The regatta is hosted and organized by the Santa Barbara Yacht Club.

2. RULES

This regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of U.S. Sailing, the rules of the applicable one-design classes (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions), and by the Sailing Instructions.

3. CLASSES

Classes invited to compete are **U.S. Sabots, Seashells, CFJ's, NS14's, Lasers, Laser Radials, Vanguard 15's, Geary 18's** and any other one-design fleet with at least four entries. Saturday's races will be scored as the U.S. Sabots High Point Regatta in Santa Barbara (Saturday's and Sunday's races will be scored as the Semana Nautica Regatta).

4. ENTRY

Competitors may enter by filling out and returning a completed entry form and paying applicable fees. Entry forms may be found on the SBYC Racing webpage (www.sbyc.org/Racing.html) or at the registration desk.

5. VENUE & SAILING AREA

Registration for Sabots and Seashell sailors will take place at the Santa Barbara harbor launch ramp at the south-eastern end of Santa Barbara harbor. Registration for all other classes will take place at the Santa Barbara Yacht Club Fleet Room located on the lower deck of the club. All post-sailing activities will take place at the Santa Barbara Yacht Club. There will be three sailing areas. Seashells and Sabot C's will sail inside Santa Barbara harbor off Seashell Beach. Sabot A's and B's will sail on a course off the end of Stearns Wharf. All double-handed boats and Lasers will sail on a course approximately .5 miles south of Santa Barbara harbor.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available on the website (www.sbyc.org/Racing.html) approximately one week prior to the event. Copies will also be available at registration.

8. BOAT STORAGE

Boats may be stored in the SBYC parking lot in designated areas during the event. Additional boat storage may be made available near the Santa Barbara harbor launch ramp.

9. SCORING

The low-point scoring system of Appendix A will apply. However, six or more races in each fleet must be completed before a discard may be applied. Three races must be completed to constitute a series.

10. PRIZES

Take home trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers in each class on Sunday, June 26, 2005. All junior participants will receive a participation prize.
