

2006 Li'Doheny Outside Regatta and Lido 14, Fleet 73 Championship Regatta



NOTICE OF RACE & GENERAL CONDITIONS

- **ORGANIZING AUTHORITY / MANAGEMENT** - The organizing authority for this regatta is the Dana Point Yacht Club. The Dana Point Yacht Club Race Committee will manage this regatta and shall have sole authority to interpret rules and conditions of the race, appoint a protest committee and to accept or reject the entry of any boat.
- **RULES** - The 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the rules of the Lido 14 one-design class, and this Notice of Race, shall govern all races except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions. This event will be held Sunday, May 21, 2006, and is classified as a Category A event in accordance with Appendix 1, Regulation 20 – ISAF Advertising Code.
- **ELIGIBILITY** - This regatta is open to all Lido 14 boats whose skippers are members in good standing of the Lido 14 Class Association. However, only members in good standing of Fleet 73, racing in Lido Class A, will be eligible for the Fleet 73 Championship.
- **ENTRIES** - Completed entries must be filed with DPYC before racing begins Sunday, May 21, 2006. Mailed entry forms should be sent to: Lido 14 Race Chairman, DPYC, 24399 Dana Drive, Dana Point, CA 92629.
- **SCHEDULE OF EVENTS** – A competitors meeting will be held at the DPYC dry storage yard on Sunday, May 21, 2006, at 1000 hours. The first warning for racing will be at 1200 hours.
- **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** - Sailing Instructions and other important information will be issued at the Competitor's meeting. Questions will be answered at that time. Sailing Instructions may also be posted on the Dana Point Website (<http://www.dpyc.org>).
- **COURSES / STARTS** – The races will be held outside Dana Point Harbor, off of Doheny beach. The Sailing Instructions will include a schedule of races and courses. Five races are scheduled. If one or more races are finished, the regatta will be regarded as complete for trophy purposes. Yachts will race in classes as entered. Skippers will be notified by the Race Committee as to the class in which they will compete. A & B Classes will start as the Race Committee may determine appropriate in light of sailing conditions and the number of entrants. Chase boats will be provided.
- **CHANGES TO RULES** – Rule 44.2 will be changed to make the alternative penalty one 360 turn, not two.
- **SCORING/TROPHIES** - The Low Point scoring system will apply except RRS Appendix A, as modified herein, no throw outs will apply. Take home trophies will be awarded to 1st 2nd and 3rd place winners of each class. **The Lido 14 Fleet 73 Championship trophy shall be awarded to the Fleet 73 member with the best score in A Class.**
- **FACILITIES** - All DPYC facilities will be available for use by skippers, crew and guests throughout the weekend, beginning Saturday afternoon. A 3,000-lb. hoist will be available for use with the assistance of a qualified DPYC member. Competitors are encouraged to place boats in the water before the Competitor's Meeting, if possible. The hoist will be available Sunday approximately from 0830 to 1030 hours. Competitors shall provide their own internal lifting sling.

In consideration of your acceptance of my entry, I and my crew hereby certify, agree and acknowledge, as follows:

- 1) I certify that my Lido 14 is in conformance with class rules and will produce a valid measurement certificate if requested to do so.
- 2) I will comply with all of the rules and regulations of the Dana Point Yacht Club ("DPYC"), other sponsors, the ISAF, US Sailing, the US Coast Guard, the fleet entered, class association rules as applicable, any other applicable governing body, and any other instructions under which this race is sailed.
- 3) Any contestant, under the supervision of the Race Committee or class measurer, may inspect my boat, before or after the race.
- 4) I and my crew are entering the race and related race activities entirely at our own risk of personal injury or property damage, and it is my sole and exclusive responsibility to decide whether or not to start or to continue the race due to weather conditions or otherwise. I am the owner or charterer of my boat. My boat is in good condition, seaworthy, and fully complies with the equipment rules and regulations of the fleet in which it is entered.
- 5) To the fullest extent allowed by law, I and my crew hereby release DPYC and any other sponsoring yacht club or organization, their officers, directors and race personnel from any and all liability whatsoever for any injury to myself, my crew, or others, including death, and damage to my boat or other boats, arising out of my and my crew's participation in the race, or any activities related to the race, to the extent that such release does not discharge my insurance carrier under the provisions of insurance policies on my boat.
- 6) I will notify DPYC immediately upon withdrawal from the race and will not thereafter sail in hazardous conflict with any other boat or commercial vessel.
