



Notice of Race:

10th Annual Lake Piru Regatta, Saturday-Sunday, May 6-7, 2006

The San Fernando Valley Yacht Club invites all club members, skippers and their friends to join us at Lake Piru, California, for our 10th Annual Lake Piru Regatta. Similar boats, small multi-hulls, and other trailerable boats up to 26 feet LOA are welcome.

RULES: The Races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, including the prescriptions of US Sailing; by applicable class rules; and by the Sailing instructions.

Four entries are required to establish a class. A Portsmouth Handicap class will be available if there are insufficient entries to establish a One-Design class. The Race Committee reserves the right to establish a sub-fleet before the start of the Regatta.

Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration, which opens at 0830 hours at the Snack Bar at Lake Piru. Registration closes at 0930 hours, when there will be a Skippers' meeting at the Snack Bar. The signal for the first race will be announced at this meeting.

The Regatta is intended to consist of five races, three on Saturday and two on Sunday; however, a minimum of three races will constitute a complete Regatta.

Scoring will be based on PHRF ratings, and the low-point scoring system will be used. No scores will be discarded (change of RRS 42).

FEES: Advance registration, received by April 24, is \$10.00. The fee for registration on or after April 25 is \$15.00.

TROPHIES: Trophies will be presented as soon as possible after the completion of sailing and the disposition of any protests. For four boats there will be one trophy; five to seven boats, 2 trophies; eight to ten boats, 3 trophies, and eleven boats or more, 4 trophies.
