2006 Lido 14 Class Championship Regatta July 10th through July 12th, 2006 Huntington Lake, California

Sponsored by Lido 14 Fleet 6 – Alamitos Bay, California Hosted by Fresno Yacht Club

General

You are invited you to participate in the 2006 Lido 14 Class Championship Regatta this coming July 10th thru 12th on Huntington Lake, California. Huntington Lake is located at the 7000' elevation of the western slopes of the High Sierra Mountains, east of Fresno California. The small boat sailing that is offered by this venue is unmatched throughout California, if not the entire west coast of the United States.

This event will follow the Lido 14 Junior Class Championship Regatta on July 7th and the annual High Sierra Regatta (hosted by Fresno Yacht Club) on Huntington Lake over the weekend of July 8th and 9th. We encourage all Lido sailors, regardless of age or skill, to participate in the Class Championship Regatta and, for those wishing additional time on the water, to also compete in the High Sierra Regatta and for junior members of the Class and eligible dependents of Senior members to consider competing in the Junior Class Championships too.

Enclosed within this Notice of Race, you will find an official entry form, official measurement checklist, and information regarding lodging in the vicinity of the regatta. We recommend that you make your lodging arrangements as soon as possible as the lake is a popular destination during the summer months.

For those of you interested in either the Junior Class Championships or the High Sierra Regatta, you can find their Notices of Race and related information on the Lido 14 Class Association website (www.lido14.org).

Rules

This regatta is governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing.

Eligibility

The Class Championship Regatta is open to all 2006 members of the Lido 14 Class Association, regardless of age, who meet the Association By-Law requirements for competing in the Division Class Championship Regatta. As is required by Class By-Law Article XVII.3, competitors shall have actively and legally raced a Lido 14 sometime between 1958 and May 11th, 2006 (i.e. at least sixty days prior to the Class Championship Regatta) to be eligible for this Regatta.

Location

The regatta site is Huntington Lake, located approximately 60 miles via Highway 168, East of Fresno, California. Fresno Yacht Club's (www.fresnoyachtclub.org/hsrdetails.htm) contains excellent information, including detailed driving directions. There are three locations where on-shore events will take place: Lakeshore Resort, located at 61953 Huntington Lake Road, Lakeshore, CA 93634, and Fresno Yacht Club's registration tent, referred herein as the Registration Area, and Deer Creek Campground. The Registration Area is located adjacent to the boat launch ramp across Huntington Lake road from Lakeshore Resort. Deer Creek Campground is adjacent (to the West) of the boat launch ramp.

Fees and Registration Forms that are not delivered on or before July 3rd, 2006 **MUST** be (re)submitted at the Registration Area.

Be sure mailed entries arrive by July 3rd to avoid the late entry fee.

All participants **MUST** check in at the Registration Area during the Registration/Check-In time periods listed in the Schedule of Events in order to submit any fees owed, their Measurement Check List (enclosed) their Official Certificate of Measurement, undergo skipper/crew weight measurement, and receive regatta materials (sailing instructions, etc.)

Annual Meeting

The Lido 14 Class Association will host the 2006 Annual Meeting at Lakeshore Resort at 6:00 P.M. on Monday July 10th. A buffet style dinner will be served. Vegetarians will be accommodated. Dress is casual. The purpose of the meeting is to conduct official Association business including election of new Class Association officers. Contact the Lido 14 Class Association for further details on the conduct and agenda of the Annual Meeting.

Potluck Party

An informal potluck/wine & cheese party will be held at a campsite in Deer Creek Campground, just West of Lakeshore Resort and the boat launch ramp, on Tuesday evening at 6:00 P.M. You are encouraged to attend and to bring a sampling of your favorite food and beverage to share around the picnic table and campfire. The specific campsite for the party will be posted at the Registration Area on or before Monday July 10th.

Awards Banquet

The awarding of championship trophies, for both the Junior and Class Championships, will occur at a banquet to be held at Lakeshore Resort at 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday evening July 12th. A choice of meals will be offered, of which one choice will be vegetarian. Dress is smart casual.

Measurement

Skipper, crew, and required ballast weights to bring their total weight to the Class minimum of 300 pounds shall be measured at the time the participants check in at the Registration Area.

A Lido 14 Class Championship Regatta Measurement Check List (enclosed) must be completed and submitted per the instructions in the Registration/Check-In instructions.

To complete their Check List, un-attached members must make arrangements for measurement of their boat with a Fleet Measurer or with the Championship Regatta Measurement Committee. The Measurement Committee will only provide measurement services for unattached members and only on a pre-arranged basis.

Contact your Fleet Measurer for a measurement appointment or to answer any measurement questions. If you do not have a Fleet Measurer, contact the Chief Measurer to make alternate measuring arrangements.

Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Regatta Registration/Check-In area at the times noted in the Schedule of Events shown above. The Sailing Instructions will include information on flights to be sailed, courses, scoring, alternative penalties, protest procedures, etc.

Racing Series

The 2006 Championship Regatta consists of two series: the Qualifying Series and the Championship Series. The purpose of the Qualifying Series is to rank the competitors so that the top one-half may be assigned to the Gold flight and the remainder to the Silver flight. The precise methodology for ranking competitors and assigning them to flights will be disclosed in the Sailing Instructions.

The team with the lowest combined score. Teams are composed of Gold and Silver flight competitors based on their ranking from the Qualifying Series. The purpose of this trophy is to promote interaction between the members of the Gold and Silver Flight competitors.

Boat Storage & Parking

The automobile/trailer parking, boat rigging, and boat launching facilities adjacent to the Lakeshore boat launch ramp (see attached Boat Launching Area Detail Map) are available for a nominal fee. These fees are not included in the Class Championship Regatta entry fee.

Boat Charters

Boat charters will not be provided.

Lodging

A good overview of the Huntington Lake area can be found on the web www.huntingtonlake.com.

The primary lodging options for competitors and their guests will be the US Forest Service Campgrounds, Lakeshore Resort (the location of the Annual Meeting and the Awards Banquet dinner), Cedar Crest Resort, and the Huntington Condominiums. Other options exist but they are increasingly distant from the center of activities.

Lakeshore Resort is at the epicenter of all regatta events. Both cabins and an RV Park are offered. The cabins are rustic – meaning they are simple and functional and “cozy”. All units have private both rooms with showers. Units come in a range of bed and kitchen combinations. The cabins are within walking distance to all regatta events.

The Lakeshore Resort RV Park has full hookups, showers, and laundry facilities. The RV Park is a long uphill walk from the shoreline whereas the cabins are closest to race headquarters and well within walking distance to restaurant, bar, store, gas, post office, launch ramp, etc. There is no lake view from cabins or RV Park.

Located 10-15 minute drive (to the West) of Lakeshore Resort along the lake’s Northern shoreline. A variety of cabins are offered. There is a restaurant and store at Cedar Crest Resort.

Huntington Lake is surrounded by a number of U.S Forest Service campgrounds. A majority of the campsites may be reserved via National Recreation Reservations System that you can contact via the phone number and web address given above. When you make a reservation, you are only insuring that you will get a site of a certain size in a certain campground - specific sites cannot be reserved. All the campgrounds are fairly equal as far as facilities go. Most, if not all, have running water and flush toilets. None have showers. Lakeshore Resort’s RV Park showers may be available to campers for a fee. Inquire at Lakeshore Resort.

All campers must check in with the Forest Service office at Huntington Lake to get their specific site assignment. This local office also manages campsites not in the reservation pool so there is a (very slight) chance that you can get a site the day you show up. Of course, it is advisable that you have reservations in hand prior to your arrival. The office is located to the junction of highway 168 (the road from Fresno to Huntington Lake) and the road to Florence and Edison lakes near the headwaters of the lake. Area campgrounds include:

Deer Creek is on the waterfront and is a short walk from Lakeshore Resort and all the facilities you will need for your stay (boat launch ramp, groceries, etc.). These are the most sought after campgrounds and as such, are usually completely reserved many months in advance. Give them a try just in case.

College, Kinnikinnick and Catavee are a bit further away (i.e. a few hundred additional yards) from most activities but still within walking distance for most people.

Rancheria (on the south side) and Billy Creek (west) are 5 to 10 minutes of driving time away.

For those whom are unable to secure reservations at Huntington or need camper hookups and electricity, this is a 20-minute drive.
