

# Notice of Race

## Harry Wood Memorial Regatta

**RULES:** This regatta is governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of the Lido 14 Class Association. Advertising is restricted to Category A per RRS Appendix 1 Regulation 20.

**DIVISIONS:** Lido 14 A, Lido 14 B, and Grand Master (skipper over the age of 50) divisions are offered. The race committee reserves the right to start two or more divisions simultaneously however all divisions will be scored separately.

**ELIGIBILITY:** This regatta is open to all teams that meet the following eligibility requirements: 1) The registered skipper is a current member of the Lido 14 Class Association; 2) the registered skipper is a current member of a yacht club recognized by the skipper's national sailing authority.

**LOCATION:** The official Race Notice Board, registration on the day of the regatta, Competitors Meeting, protest related events, after-race buffet and awards presentation are all located at Balboa Yacht Club (BYC) which is at 1801 Bayside Drive, Corona Del Mar, CA. BYC's telephone number is (949) 673-3515.

Races, unless otherwise noted, will be held in the main basin of Newport bay, west of Balboa Island.

**SCHEDULE:** Five (5) races are scheduled with a 15-minute break after the second race.

**ENTRY:** Advance registration is available by completing the associated entry form and either depositing it in the race entry mail slot at BYC or by mailing it to BYC at the address provided below. Mailed entries must be received by BYC no later than March 29<sup>th</sup> (Saturday). Registration on the day of the regatta will be on the BYC Flag Deck. Sailing Instructions and course charts will be available the day of the regatta at the registration desk.

**SCORING:** The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, shall apply except that each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. This changes RRS A2. Three (3) completed races shall constitute a series.

**FACILITIES:** The hospitality of BYC and its facilities, except on site automobile parking, are extended to all competitors. Boats are launched at BYC via a hoist; boats must be equipped with an internal lifting sling.

**TROPHIES:** Perpetual Trophies will be awarded for first place in each division. Take home trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew for the top three (3) boats in the A division and the top boat in each of the B and Grand Master divisions.
