



Notice of Race for Balboa Yacht Club's
Harry Wood Memorial Regatta
 Sunday March 28, 2010



RULES: This regatta is governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of the Lido 14 Class Association.

DIVISIONS: Lido 14 A, Lido 14 B, and Grand Master (skipper over the age of 60) divisions are offered. The race committee reserves the right to start two or more divisions simultaneously.

ELIGIBILITY: This regatta is open to all boats that meet the following eligibility requirements: 1) The registered skipper is a current member of the Lido 14 Class Association; 2) the registered skipper is a current member of a yacht club or sailing organization recognized by the skipper's national sailing authority.

LOCATION: The official Race Notice Board, registration on the day of the regatta, Competitors Meeting, protest related events, buffet and awards presentation are all located at Balboa Yacht Club (BYC) which is at 1801 Bayside Drive, Corona Del Mar, CA. BYC's telephone number is (949) 673-3515.

Races, unless otherwise noted, will be held in the main basin of Newport bay, west of Balboa Island.

SCHEDULE: Five (5) races are scheduled with a 15-minute break after the second race.

ENTRY: The Entry Fee is \$15. Registration and entry fee payment is available online via the "Online Registration" facility in the "ON THE WATER" tab of BYC's website (www.balboayachtclub.com). Registration and entry fee payment on the day of the regatta will also be available at the BYC Sailing Office located on the lower level of the BYC clubhouse; cash and checks payable to Balboa Yacht Club are accepted. Sailing Instructions and course charts will be available the day of the regatta at the BYC Sailing Office.

SCORING: The RRS Low Point Scoring System shall apply except that each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. This changes RRS A2. Three (3) completed races shall constitute a series.

FACILITIES: The hospitality of BYC and its facilities, **except on site automobile parking**, are extended to all competitors. **Note that street construction on Bayside Drive limits travel and on street parking in the vicinity of BYC. Traffic is restricted to the southbound direction and on street parking is only available along Bayside Drive between Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club and BYC's North Yard. Off Street automobile parking is available in parking lots in the neighborhood, details of which will be published separately. Please check back for details.** On site trailer parking is provided. Boats are launched at BYC via a hoist; boats must be equipped with an internal lifting sling.

TROPHIES: Perpetual trophies will be awarded for first place in each division. Take home trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew for the top three (3) boats in the A division and the top boat in each of the B and Grand Master divisions.
