Notice of Race

Lake Piru is a wonderful camping/fishing/boating recreational area located in Ventura County, CA, only 20 miles west of Magic Mountain.

RULES:

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including the prescriptions of US Sailing, applicable class rules, and these sailing instructions. A personal flotation device shall be worn at all times while on the water, except when adding or removing clothing between races, regardless of whether the code flag "Y" is flown.

Eligibility and Entry

The Regatta is open to all boats 26 feet LOA or less. Four one-design boats will make up a class, and boats that are not eligible to race in a one-design class may race in a Portsmouth handicap fleet. The race committee reserves the right to establish a sub-fleet before the start of the regatta. Membership in a yacht club is not required.

Advance registration (received by April 23) is \$10.00 and is recommended so that classes can be established; entry forms are available at SFVYC.us and can be mailed to the race chairman with a check payable to SFVYC. Later registration is \$15.00 and can be made up to the skippers' meeting on the day of the race. Registration opens at 8:00 AM on April 30 at the Lake Piru snack bar. Competitors under age 18 must have their entry form signed by their parent or guardian.

Skippers' Meeting, Sailing Instructions, and Course Charts

At 10:00 AM on April 30th there will be a mandatory skippers' meeting at the Lake Piru Snack bar, where the Sailing Instructions and the course chart will be distributed (the Sailing Instructions may also be available at SFVYC.us after March 1). The regatta is intended to consist of 5 races, 3 on Saturday and 2 on Sunday. 3 races shall constitute a completed regatta. Low point scoring shall be used and no score shall be discarded.

Results and Prizes

The race results for Saturday will be announced and posted at the SFVYC Grand Party on Saturday evening, which will be held in the Lake Piru Camping area. All competitors, crew and friends are invited to attend.

Final results will be announced and trophies will be awarded shortly after the completion of the last race on Sunday. There will be two trophies for classes with 5-7 boats, three for 8-10, and four for 11+.
